Hunter Ozmer's family is continuing their quest to find a cure for Niemann-Pick Disease. Niemann-Pick Disease (NPD) is the name given to a group of genetic disorders, with three commonly recognized forms: Types A, B and C.

Types A and B NPD are both caused by a deficiency of enzyme activity within the body that eventually causes cell death and malfunction of major organs.

Symptoms of Type A appear very early in childhood and include feeding difficulties, a large abdomen and progressive loss of motor skills. Children with Type A usually decline rapidly and die by age two or three. Type B victims are not as devastated but may be plagued with repeated respiratory infections.

Hunter Ozmer had Type C, which prevented her body from metabolizing cholesterol properly, and caused it to accumulate in vital organs.

Most Type C sufferers are children of school age. Symptoms include difficulty with vertical eye movement, clumsiness, slurred speech, learning difficulties and progressive intellectual decline, sudden loss of muscle tone and falls, tremors and seizures.

Type C children may live into their mid to late teens. Very few survive into their twenties.

Currently there is no cure for Niemann-Pick Disease. But there is hope. Research into treatment and prevention has made important progress. Your help is urgently needed to continue that progress.
