Making the Most of Your Visit to the NNPf Web Site

Chock-full of information, the National Niemann-Pick Disease Foundation (NNPDF) Web site (www.nnpdf.org) serves as a vital, accurate and up-to-date source for information about Niemann-Pick Disease. The Web site is updated frequently -- sometimes several times a day. Information is supplied by reliable sources and experts in the field, with regular reviews and updates. The NNPf site serves a worldwide audience, as evidenced by the ever-increasing number of contacts received from around the globe. A recent month's data shows well over 250,000 hits to the NNPf Web site with almost 4100 unique visitors. Without a doubt, the NNPf's Web site is an invaluable resource for anyone who has an interest in, or who is affected by, Niemann-Pick Disease. As such, the site is an ongoing priority for the NNPf's Family Services program.

While we strive to ensure the NNPf Home page is user-friendly with links to the latest news and hot topics, the Web site has many pages and contains a great deal of information. Here are a few tips to help you find the content you need and make the most of your visits to the NNPf Web site:

1. **Pico Search** – Every page of the NNPf Web site has a “Picosearch” tool in the blue area along the left hand side of the page. The Picosearch tool will search only the NNPf Web site (not the entire internet) for the term you enter. Example: Type “zavesca” (without the quotation marks) in the Picosearch field and click the “Go” button. You should then see a list of pages (and corresponding links) where Zavesca is mentioned.
2. **Index** – Visit www.nnpdf.org/IndexofPages.html for a list of pages included in the Web site, organized by topic. Scroll down to see the various topic groupings, and click on the links to visit each individual page.
3. **NewsLine** – The NewsLine page www.nnpdf.org/aboutus_14.html is the number one place to check for what is new to the Web site. The latest news and information and links to other updated pages within the site are all posted to the NewsLine. If you only have a few minutes to “stop in” at the NNPf Web site, be sure to hit the NewsLine page for a quick update. (The NNPf Home page www.nnpdf.org has several convenient links to the NewsLine.)
4. **Latest Research page** – For the latest in NPD research news, visit www.nnpdf.org/npdisease_14.html . Updates to this page are also generally noted on the NewsLine page, to insure you don't miss out on the latest news and developments.
5. **Blog** – Check out the NNPf blog at <http://npdf.blogspot.com> . Each page of the Web site has a link to the blog. In the blue area on the left side, click on the icon with the stylized white letter “B” in an orange square. Once at the blog, you can subscribe via email (delivered by “Feedburner”). Once subscribed, you will receive an email each time a new blog post has been made.
