To whom it may concern:


On behalf of the Canadian Chapter of the National Niemann-Pick Disease Foundation it is an honor once again to be selected as a recipient of the proceeds from the "8th Annual Life for Luke Dinner Gala" to be held Saturday, March 7, 2009.

Hundreds of thousands of dollars are spent each year for research on Niemann-Pick Disease. The current scientific environment of Niemann-Pick Disease has seen a change in emphasis from a basic research priority to one of translational research and emerging clinical research. In order to support these advances in research new tools are required; better animal models; international patient registries; natural history studies; newborn screening and carrier screening all need money in order to proceed.

It has been 3 years now since Lucy and Enio lost their precious son Luke at the tender age of eight. Niemann-Pick Disease affects children in their prime and currently has no treatment or cure. We believe that there are approximately 1,700 cases of Niemann-Pick Types A, B, and C worldwide at this point, although there is a distinct likelihood that many more cases exist undiagnosed.

The Liegghio's are an amazing family that inspire all of us to continue the battle to eradicate this deadly disease. Your support of this family's efforts are very much appreciated.
